General information - Cleaning

WARNING - When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed. Failure to comply with these instructions may cause a fire, electrical shocks or other injury to persons or property.

- 1 Children of less than 3 years should be kept away unless continuously supervised. 2 Children between 3 and 8 years old should only be allowed to switch the appliance on/off, provided that it has been correctly installed in its intended operating position and they have been given supervision or instruction concerning the safe use of the appliance and understand the hazards involved. They should not plug in, regulate, perform maintenance or clean the appliance. 3 CAUTION — Some parts of this product can become very hot and cause burns. Particular attention has to be given where children and vulnerable people are present.
- 4 DO NOT position the heater on soft surfaces or where openings may become 19 WARNING: This heater is not equipped with a device to control the room blocked. Ensure the base is fitted and fully assembled, and the unit is upright on a flat stable surface before operating. This heater is designed for use on Patios and in Beer gardens & smoking areas. The unit has been IP55 Weatherproof approved; however, to prolong the life of the heater it is strongly recommended that the heater is stored in a dry place during heavy rain and when not in use cover the appliance with the cover provided. 5 DO NOT hide the power cord in long grass or leave close to an operating
- lawnmower. Arrange the cord away from areas where it may be tripped over. 6 DO NOT insert or allow objects to touch the heating element and never place anything on the heater safety guard (e.g. towels), as this may damage the heater and could cause an electrical shock or fire. Never use your heater to dry washing. If the heating element has stopped glowing it may still be live, please check that the heat setting indicates the heater is off. 7 Always disconnect your appliance from the mains before any cleaning.
- 8 DO NOT use the heater in areas where petrol, paint, or other flammable substances are stored.
- 9 Always unplug the heater when not in use. To disconnect from the power supply, grip the plug and pull from the power socket. Never pull by the cord.
- 10 WARNING: To reduce the risk of fire, keep textiles, curtains, or any other
- flammable material a minimum distance of 1 m from the air outlet.
- 11 Extreme care should be taken when the heater is used near children and pets. 12 In order to avoid overheating, do not cover the heater.
- 13 If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- 14 Never locate the heater where it may fall into a swimming pool or other





- Incorrect use, e.g. overloading of the appliance, use of non-approved accessories
- Use of force, damage caused by external influences Damage caused by non-observance of the user manual, e.g. connection to an unsuitable mains supply or non-compliance with the installation
- Partially or completely dismantled appliances.

Parasol mounting instructions (Ceilpara type)

Heater could be mounted under Parasol of Side-post type or Pully type (pole diameter max 50mm). When closing the Parasol, please wait till the Heater cools down. It is not necessarily to take the Heater off but just to loosen the Chains.




Mounting to Side-post type parasol Remove the three screws for Loop Plate (see Hanging Instruction), replace them by the Side Loop Screws(D) and hook the Chains(E) with the Loops. Bind the Chains(E) with the Beams/Ribs of the parasol till catch solidly. Plug the Cable

to Mains and the mounting is done.

Mounting to parasol of Pully type


- (see Hanging Instruction). Fasten the Side Loop Screws(D) into the three screw holes. Then hook the Chains(E) with Ds. 2 Using a tool to push out the Central Hole Filler from the top of the Heater through its central hole -- right picture.
- 3 Slide the Heater(A) through its central hole upto the bottom position of the Beams/Ribs of the parasol. Use the Chains(E) to bind the Beams/Ribs till catch them solidly. Plug the Cable to Mains and the mounting is done.




Assembly (Poling & Table type)

Lie Heater body(A) on its box/filling to avoid scratching and for easy assembly with the Pole/Base.



- **S.4** Insert the Cable(F) through the Pole H3 (from its end with flange), the Base(I, from its bottom side), the Pole H2 (from its end without plastic part) consequently. For Table type MHT308 the Cable through the Ring fastener, Tabletop and Decorative rubber Cup(K) as shown in Picture 4.
- **5.5** Then connect the Cable(F) with the Fixed cable from the Heater as shown in Pic 2. Better to plug in the Mains and turn on the heater to check the connection is tight before go further Roll H2 with H3 on their threads to fasten them together. Then insert H1 into H2 as shown in Pic 3. Adjust the height then roll the Plastic Fastener to fix the two Poles.
- For Table type, move the Tabletop to desired height and fix it by a spanner & screw driver (Pic 4). Put the Decorative rubber Cup in position between the Pole & Table. **S.7** Drive the 3 Nuts & Washers (I, flat Washer, spring Washer, Nut consequently) to the thread bolts on the bottom of the Base till the pole fixed to the Base tightly -- Pic 5. Pull the Cable(E) gently till feeling there is no extra curve in the Pole and then fix the cable with the two Strip Fixers/Screws(G) at the bottom side of the Base.
- **S.8** (For Noth America) Drive the Concreate Anchor screw(J) to the ground or the place desired. Connect the Base through its built-in bolt scew with the Anchor screw by the plate, Nuts & washers(J) and the assembly is done (Pic 5).



Trouble shooting

Problem	Possible cause	Solution
Heater or Light won't operate	Power Switch OFF No Power to unit	Turn Power Switches ON. Check the mains or the electrical socket to restore circuit. For Poling/Table type, also check the cable receptacle is solidly connected or not (refer to Page 5 Assembly Pic
	Power Cord damaged	Inspect power cable for cuts, breaks and kinks. Replacement power cords and fittin instructions can be obtained from the technical helpdesk see warranty card.
	Heater not on right level or Safety tip-over Switch malfunction	There is a Tilt Switch so ensure the Heater is at horizental level. Give the unit a rigore shake which may reset the switch. If this does not rectify the problem, please call the technical helpdesk – see warranty card.
